Our tour will be highlighted by an inside visit to Gaudí's famous **Sagrada Familia Church**. Board the **Norwegian Spirit** in time for lunch! (All meals beginning with lunch today are included on the ship.)

Saturday, February 16 - Casablanca, Morocco

Casablanca is a city filled with an interesting mix of Moroccan traditions and modern life. Take one of the ship's optional excursions to discover Rabat's rich history and see its major treasures. Explore the archaeological site of Chellah or visit the Kasbah of Oudaya and the beautiful Andalusian Gardens.
